Due to narrow doors and aisle ways some of our train services have limited accessible provisions:

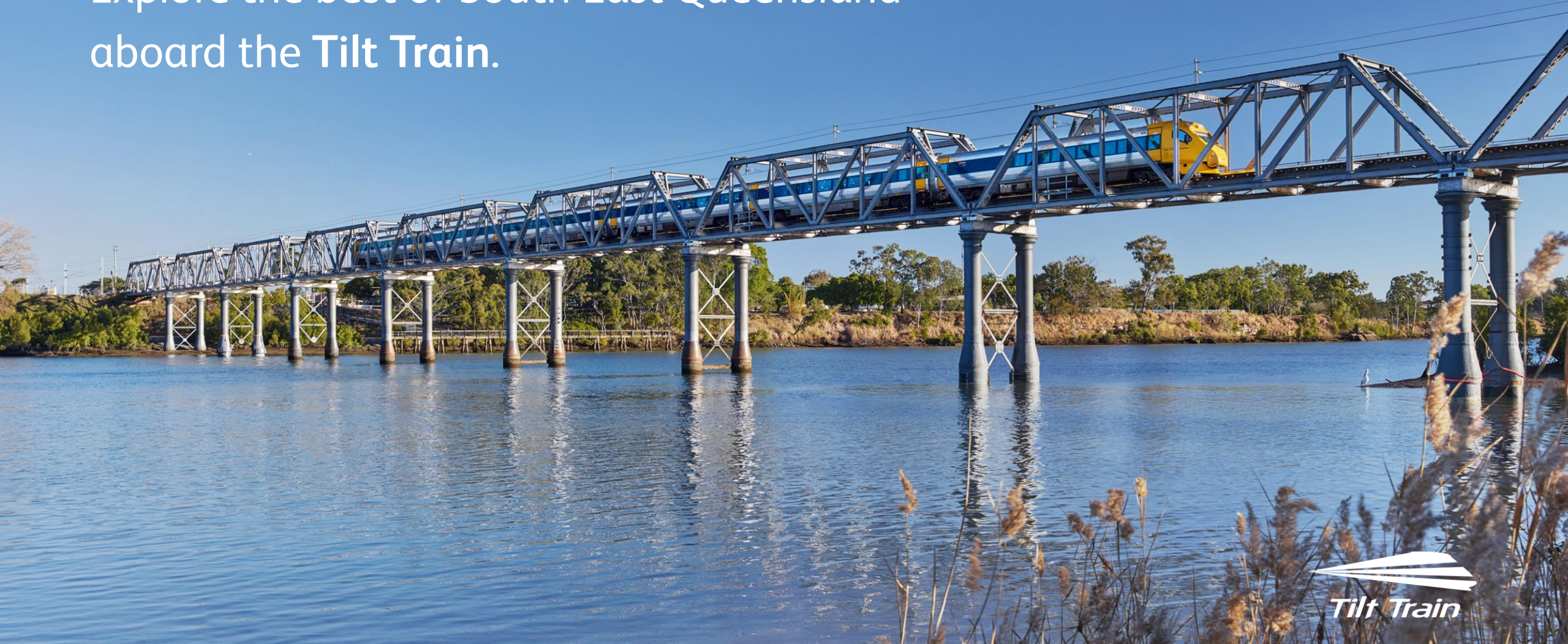

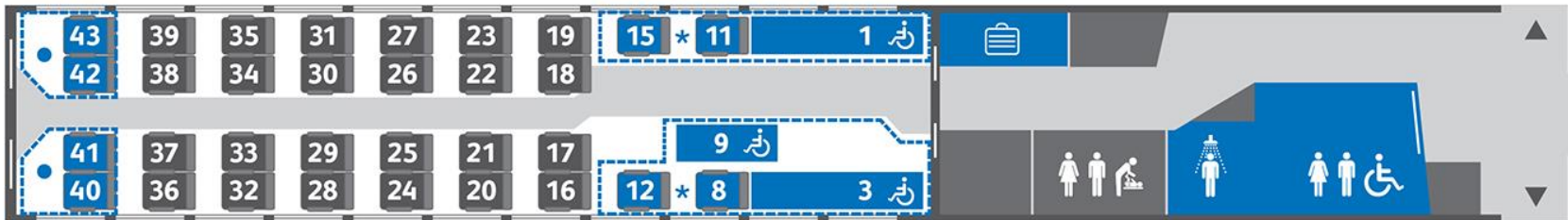

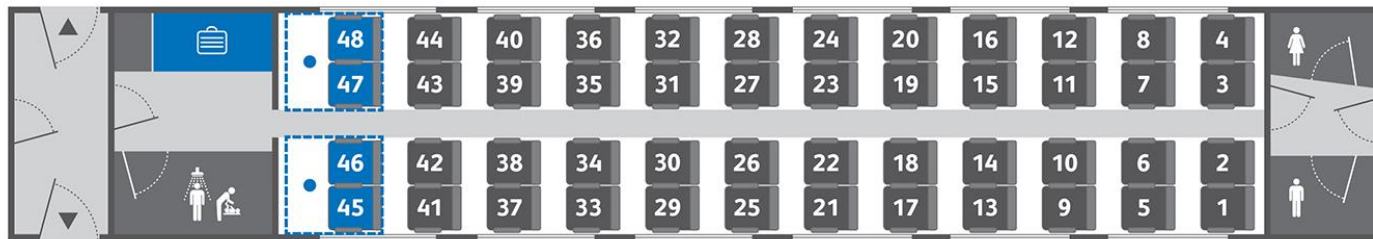

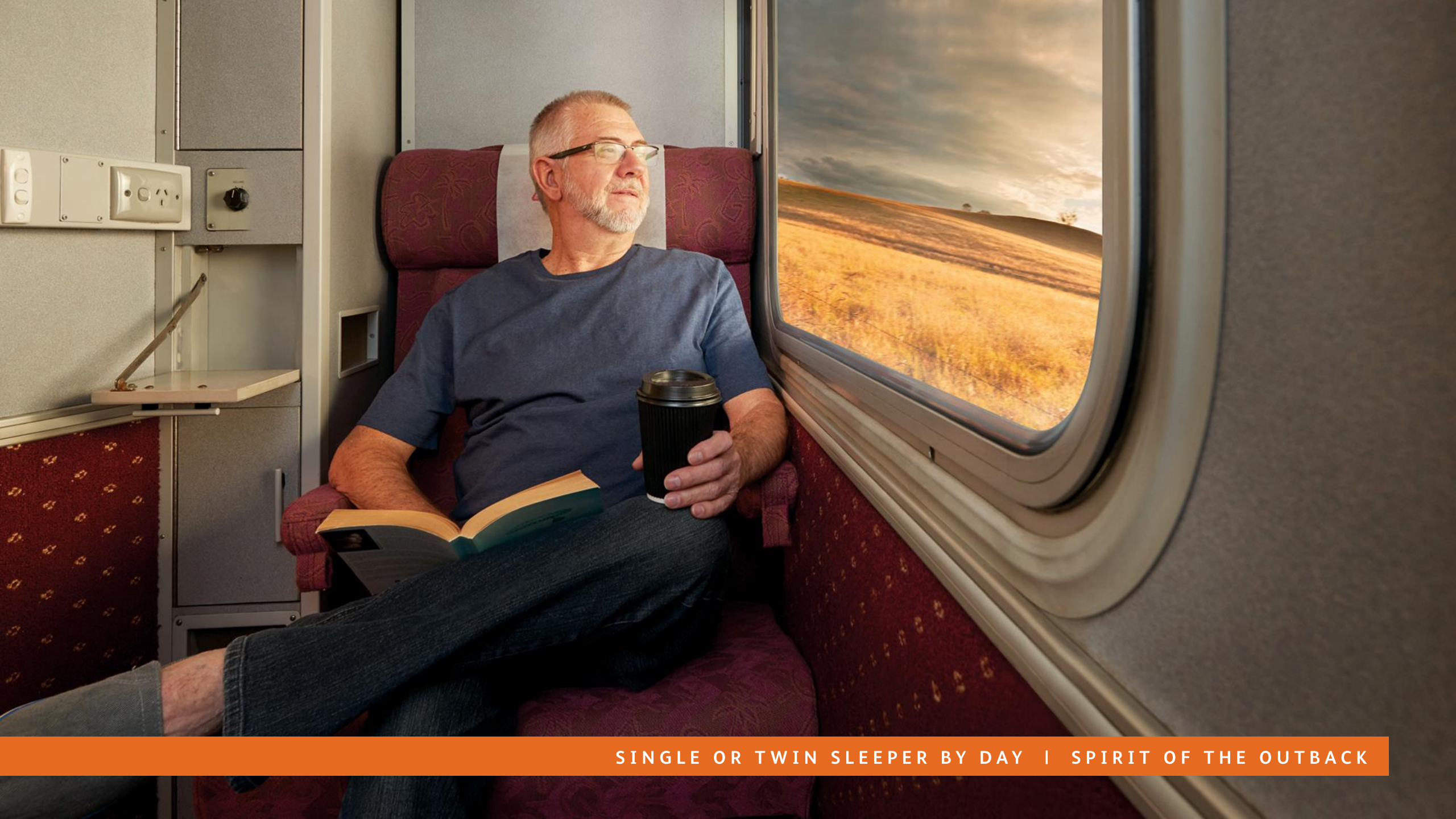

KURANDA SCENIC RAILWAY

Kuranda Scenic Railway is a heritage style service there are some points to consider when planning your journey.

- Kuranda Scenic Railway's standard heritage carriages have steep ladder style stairs with a grab rail at the top of the stairs.
- An accessible carriage is available on every Kuranda Scenic Railway service.
- The accessible carriage has high visibility handrails, contrasting surface colours inside the carriage with raised text and Braille on toilet signs.
- Most types of wheelchairs, walking frames or mobility scooters can be accommodated (*size restrictions do apply*)
- Platform heights, station facilities and access vary, and we recommend you review relevant station information when planning your journey.

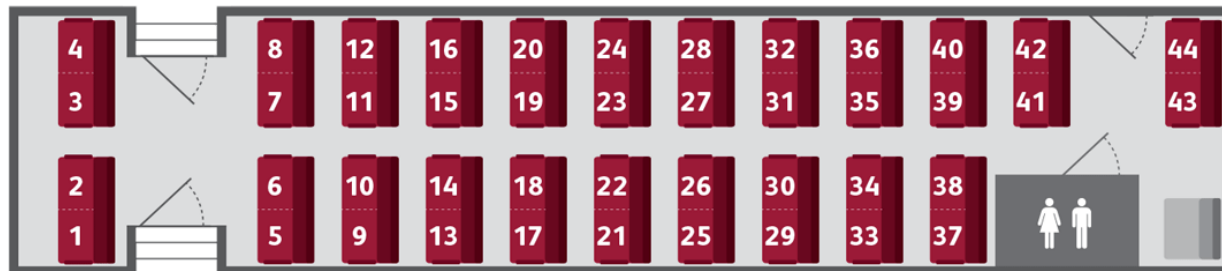
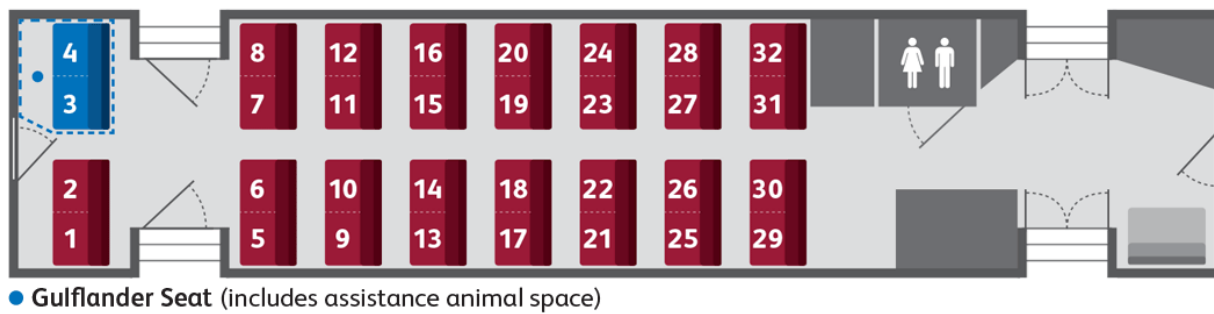
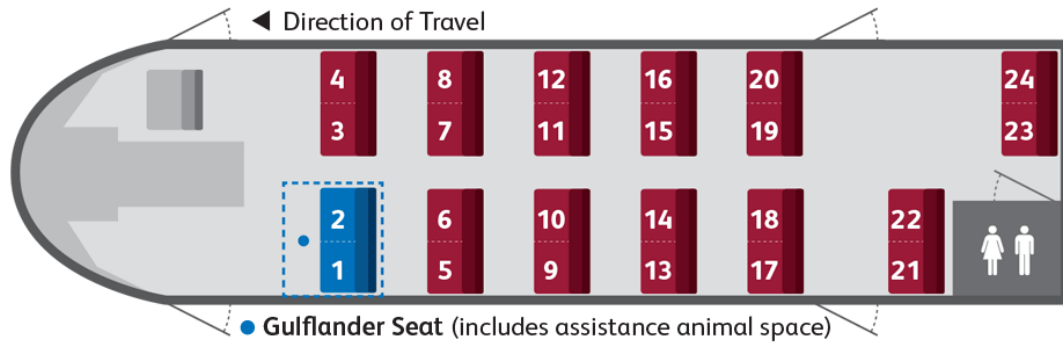
- The traditional and unique style of rail travel offered by the Gulflander is not accessible to customers who use a wheelchair or mobility scooter to join or leave the train
- Certified assistance animals are permitted on board
- The train does not have facilities to assist customers who are deaf or hard of hearing or are blind or have low vision
- All platforms on the Gulflander line are at ground level
- Gulflander carriages are accessed by narrow steps attached to the train, with handrails provided

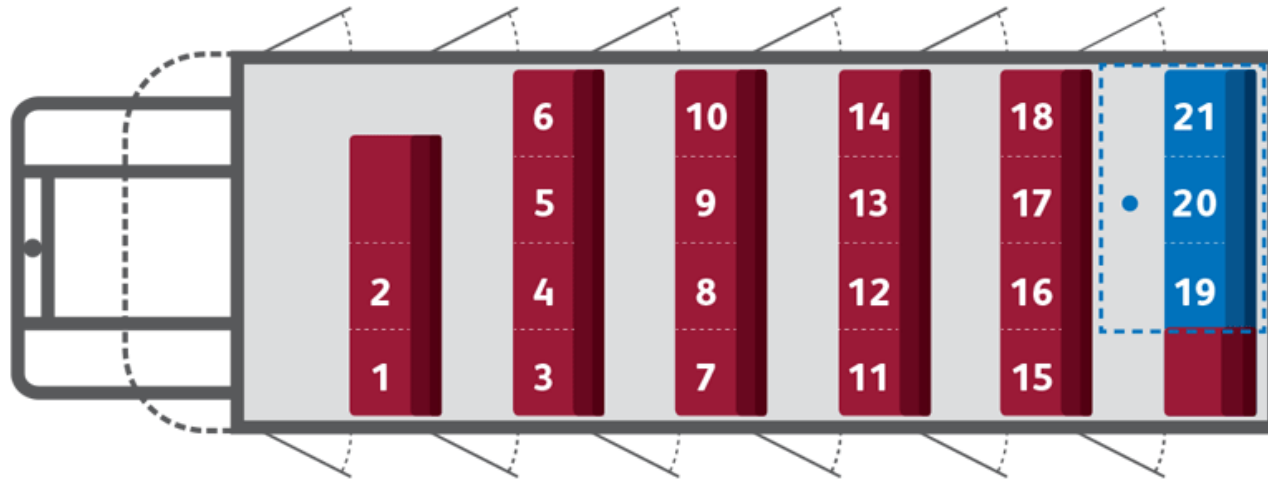
